## **Camp Costs**

The \$525 cost of camp includes meals and a double room. Single rooms are \$30/camp extra. Registrants may pay in full less applicable discounts, or pay a \$100 deposit through April 30. Full payment for all registrations is due May 1. Your credit card is charged for the balance, or a check is due at this time.

## **Camp Discounts Policy**

\$30 early registration discount for those who pay in full by February 28, 2012; \$20 group discount for groups of four to seven; \$30 group discount for groups of eight to sixteen; \$50 group discount for groups of seventeen to twenty-five; \$75 group discount for groups of twenty-six or more. Group discounts first require action by a group leader, who emails to tennisandlifecamps@gustavus.edu a list of all potential group participants, their emails, and the anticipated number of people who will attend. When group members register, they indicate their group leader and his/her email. Members of a group need to attend the same camp. Anyone claiming the early registration discount cannot be part of a group. Early registration and group discounts cannot be combined.

## **Awards Policy**

All award applications are merit based, require a letter of recommendation, and are due March 1. All applicants must be in the eighth grade or younger. NCAA rules prohibit us from giving awards to high school students. Award recipients are announced March 15. Unsuccessful applicants can cancel and received a full deposit refund until March 31. The Karen Gibbs Award and the Karen Gibbs Courage Award are \$250 awards that require a camp application and deposit. The Eric Butorac Awards are limited to youth who are unable to attend camp without financial aid. All award applications and recommendations are submitted by email to tennisandlifecamps@gustavus.edu before March 1. Click on awards for complete descriptions of the awards and the application process.

## **Cancellation Policy**

\$100 fee for all cancellations prior to three weeks before your camp begins and no refunds afterwards. In the case of a medical emergency that is verified by a physician and where we receive notification by noon of the day preceding camp, the cancellation fee is \$100. Any other withdrawal in no guaranteed refund. Any cancellation fee can be avoided by finding a substitute not already registered for a camp.

There is a complete refund for all unsuccessful TLC award applicants who cancel before April 1, 2012.

# **Waiting List Policy**

A waiting list camper registers and pays a \$100 deposit by credit card or check. He/she may cancel and receive a full refund at any time prior to his/her acceptance in the camp. When there is an opening, TLC emails and calls the top person on the waiting list. If the person accepts, the remaining balance is collected on May 1 or the date of acceptance, whichever is later. If the applicant does not respond within 24 hours, TLC withdraws the offer for admission and moves on to the next waiting list candidate. A non-accepted camper is credited \$100 for the deposit on the first day of camp.

## **Other Camp Policies**

Non-tennis players may accompany campers, stay in a dormitory room, eat in the dining service, and use campus facilities for \$175. The cost per person for meals only is \$125 and for a dormitory room only is \$60. Deduction for adults or families staying off campus and eating in the dining service is \$40 per person. A junior (16 or older) may register with an accompanying adult for an adult camp. An adult may attend any junior camp. No refund is made for late arrival or early departure.
